2025-2027 Capital Budget-Conclusions



- OCRs 25-27 capital budget proposal = \$57.5 million.
- YBIPs 25-27 capital budget proposal = \$59 million.
- YRBWEP 25-27 capital budget proposal = \$4 million.
- Capital Budget Spending Plan included in budgeting process.
- Governor's budget proposal expected in December 2024.
